I am not sure that you can do this, but if you give me all the information about your existing drive, I will talk to the Yamaha boys and see if it can be done.

I will mention that jet drives are less effective than props at the same horsepower as the jets operate effeciently over a much reduced range. As a rule of thumb we usually figure that you need 20-30% more HP for the jet to have about the same performance.
